## **REMOVAL**

# 1. DISCHARGE REFRIGERANT FROM REFRIGERATION SYSTEM


HINT:

At the time of installation, please refer to the following item.

Evacuate air from refrigeration system.

Charge system with refrigerant and inspect for leakage of refrigerant.

Specified amount : 600  $\pm$  50 g (21.16  $\pm$  1.76 oz.)




### 2. REMOVE AIR CLEANER DUCT

Remove the 2 bolts and air cleaner duct.

- 3. REMOVE ECU OUTLET DUCT
- 4. REMOVE 2 RADIATOR UPPER SUPPORTS

Remove the 2 bolts and upper supports.



#### 5. DISCONNECT DISCHARGE HOSE AND LIQUID TUBE

Remove the 2 bolts and disconnect the hose and tube.

Torque: 10 N·m (100 kgf·cm, 7 ft·lbf)

### NOTICE:

Cap the open fittings immediately to keep moisture or dirt out of the system.

HINT:

At the time of installation, please refer to the following item. Lubricate 2 new O-rings with compressor oil and install them to the hose and tube.



- (a) Remove the 4 bolts and 2 brackets.
- (b) Push the radiator toward engine.
- (c) Push the condenser toward radiator and pull it upward.

HINT:

At the time of installation, please refer to the following item. If condenser is replaced, add compressor oil to the condenser.

Add 40 cc (1.4 fl. oz)

Compressor oil: ND - OIL 8 or equivalent
