

## REMOVAL

### HINT:


When repairing the oil pump, the oil pan and strainer should be removed and cleaned.

- 1. DRAIN ENGINE OIL
- 2. REMOVE TIMING BELT AND OIL PUMP PULLEY (See page EM-20)



#### 3. REMOVE OIL PUMP

- (a) Remove the 6 bolts and oil pump.
- (b) Remove the O-ring.
- 4. REMOVE RH AND LH STIFFENER PLATES




## 5. REMOVE OIL LEVEL SENSOR

- (a) Disconnect the level sensor connector.
- (b) Remove the 4 bolts and level sensor.


#### NOTICE:

Be careful not to drop the oil level sensor when removing it.



## 6. REMOVE OIL PAN

- (a) Remove the oil dipstick.
- (b) Remove the 22 bolts and 2 nuts.




(c) Insert the blade of SST between the cylinder block and oil pan, and cut off applied sealer and remove the oil pan.

## **NOTICE:**

- Do not use SST for the timing belt case and rear oil seal retainer.
- Be careful not to damage the oil pan flange.

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# 7. REMOVE OIL STRAINER

Remove the bolt, 2 nuts, oil strainer and gasket.
