


## **REMOVAL**

### 1. REMOVE FRONT WHEEL




# 2. DISCONNECT ABS SPEED SENSOR AND WIRE HARNESS CLAMP

- (a) Remove the bolt and disconnect the ABS speed sensor from the steering knuckle.
- (b) Remove the bolt and disconnect the ABS speed sensor wire harness clamp from the shock absorber.
- 3. DISCONNECT UPPER SUSPENSION ARM FROM STEERING KNUCKLE
- (a) Remove the clip and nut.



- (b) Using SST, disconnect the upper suspension arm. SST 09610-20012
- (c) Support the steering knuckle securely.




### 4. DISCONNECT STABILIZER BAR LINK FROM STABI-LIZER BAR

Remove the nut and disconnect the stabilizer bar link.

#### HINT:


If the ball joint turns together with the nut, use a 5 mm hexagon wrench to hold the stud.



# 5. REMOVE FRONT SHOCK ABSORBER WITH COIL SPRING

- (a) Remove the nut and bolt, and disconnect the shock absorber from the shock absorber bracket.
- (b) Remove the cap from the suspension support.

LEXUS IS200 (RM684E)



(c) Loosen the nut in the center of the suspension support.

#### NOTICE:

## Do not remove it.

#### HINT:

If not disassembling the shock absorber, it is not necessary to loosen the nut.

- (d) Remove the 3 nuts, No. 1 front spring reinforcement and shock absorber with coil spring from the body.
- (e) Remove the No. 3 front spring reinforcement from the shock absorber.
