

EXTENSION HOUSING OIL SEAL ON-VEHICLE REPAIR

- REMOVE NO. 1 AND NO. 2 ENGINE UNDER COVERS
- 2. REMOVE LH FRONT FLOOR CENTER COVER
- 3. REMOVE NO. 1 REAR FLOOR BOARD
- 4. POSITION PAN TO CATCH ANY FLUID THAT MAY DRIP
- 5. REMOVE EXHAUST PIPE ASSEMBLY (See page EM-99)
- 6. REMOVE PROPELLER SHAFT (See page PR-4)



7. REMOVE EXTENSION HOUSING OIL SEAL

Using SST, remove the oil seal. SST 09308-00010



8. INSTALL EXTENSION HOUSING OIL SEAL

(a) Using SST and a hammer, carefully drive a new oil seal in as far as it will go.

SST 09325-20010

Oil seal drive in depth:5.4 – 5.8 mm(0.21 – 0.22 in.) NOTICE:

Clean the extension housing before removing the oil seal.

- (b) Coat the lip of a new oil seal with MP grease.

- 11. FILL ATF AND CHECK FLUID LEVEL (See page DI-170)
