


1. REMOVE RADIATOR ASSEMBLY

(See page CO-15)




2. REMOVE DRIVE BELT AND WATER PUMP PULLEY

- (a) At first, loosen the 4 nuts of the water pump pulley.
- (b) Remove the drive belt.
- (c) Remove the 4 nuts and water pump pulley.
- 3. REMOVE TIMING BELT AND IDLER PULLEY (See page EM-17)




4. REMOVE WATER BYPASS OUTLET AND NO.1 WATER BYPASS PIPE

- (a) Remove the 2 bolts, water bypass outlet and No.1 water bypass pipe.
- (b) Remove the 3 O-rings from the water bypass outlet and No.1 water bypass pipe.
- 5. REMOVE WATER INLET AND THERMOSTAT (See page CO-9)




6. REMOVE WATER PUMP

- (a) Loosen the nut and remove the bolt, slide the generator away from the water pump.
- (b) Remove the bolt, and disconnect the clamp bracket (for engine wire).
- (c) Remove the bolt, and disconnect the connector bracket (for crankshaft position sensor connector).



- (d) Disconnect the water bypass hose from the No. 3 water bypass pipe.
- (e) Remove the 2 nuts, gasket and No. 3 water bypass pipe from the water pump.



- (f) Remove the 6 bolts, water pump and gasket.
- (g) Remove the drain hose.
- (h) Remove the O-ring from the cylinder block.
