
SPIRAL CABLE

COMPONENTS



REMOVAL

- 1. PRECAUTION CAUTION: Be sure to read the "PRECAUTION" thoroughly before servicing (See page RS-1).
- 2. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL CAUTION: Wait for 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable to prevent the airbag working
- 3. PLACE FRONT WHEELS FACING STRAIGHT AHEAD
- 4. REMOVE STEERING WHEEL NO.3 COVER LOWER (See page RS-387)
- 5. REMOVE STEERING WHEEL NO.2 COVER LOWER (See page RS-387)
- 6. REMOVE STEERING PAD (See page RS-388)
- 7. REMOVE STEERING WHEEL ASSEMBLY (for Manual Tilt) (See page SR-40)
- 8. REMOVE STEERING WHEEL ASSEMBLY (for Power Tilt and Power Telescopic) (See page SR-50)
- 9. REMOVE STEERING COLUMN COVER (for Manual Tilt) (See page SR-40)
- 10. REMOVE STEERING COLUMN COVER (for Power Tilt and Power Telescopic) (See page SR-51)
- 11. REMOVE SPIRAL CABLE
 - (a) Disconnect the connectors from the spiral cable. **NOTICE:**

When handling the airbag connector, take care not to damage the airbag wire harness.

- (b) Disengage the 3 claws and remove the spiral cable.
- 12. REMOVE STEERING ANGLE SENSOR (See page BC-128)
