  - (a) Perform a diagnostic system check (See page RS-25).

  - (a) Perform a diagnostic system check (See page RS-25).
- 3. INSPECT CENTER AIRBAG SENSOR ASSEMBLY (VEHICLE INVOLVED IN COLLISION AND AIRBAG HAS DEPLOYED)


