INSTALLATION

1. INSTALL CENTER AIRBAG SENSOR ASSEMBLY

- (a) Check that the ignition switch is off.
- (b) Check that the battery negative (-) terminal is disconnected.

CAUTION:

After disconnecting the negative battery terminal, wait for at least 90 seconds before starting the operation.

(c) Temporarily install the center airbag sensor assembly with the 3 bolts.

NOTICE:


- If the center airbag sensor assembly has been dropped, or there are any cracks, dents or other defects in the case, bracket or connector, replace it with a new one.
- When installing the center airbag sensor assembly, be careful that the SRS wiring does not interfere with other parts and that it is not pinched between other parts.
- (d) Tighten the 3 bolts to the specified torque. Torque: 17.5 N*m (179 kgf*cm, 13 ft.*lbf)
- (e) Check that there is no looseness in the installation parts of the center airbag sensor assembly.
- (f) Connect the 3 connectors to the center airbag sensor assembly.
- (g) Check that the water-proof sheet is properly set.
- 2. INSTALL AIR DUCT REAR NO.1
- 3. INSTALL AIR DUCT REAR NO.2
- 4. INSTALL CONSOLE COVER LOWER
 - (a) Connect the connector to the console cover lower.
 - (b) Install the console cover lower with the 2 screws.
- 5. INSTALL CONSOLE BOX NO.1 DUCT
- INSTALL REAR CONSOLE BOX (See page IP-39)
- 7. INSTALL CONSOLE BOX HOLE COVER (See page IP-40)
- 8. INSTALL CONSOLE BOX NO.2 HOLE COVER HINT:


Use the same procedures for the console box No.2 hole cover and the console box hole cover.

- 9. INSTALL INSTRUMENT PANEL FINISH PANEL LOWER CENTER (See page IP-27)
- 10. INSTALL FLOOR CARPET COVER CENTER LH (See page IP-27)
- 11. INSTALL FLOOR CARPET COVER CENTER RH HINT:

Use the same procedures for the floor carpet cover center RH and the floor carpet cover center LH.







- 12. INSTALL GLOVE COMPARTMENT DOOR ASSEMBLY (See page IP-27)
- 13. INSTALL INSTRUMENT PANEL NO.2 UNDER COVER SUB-ASSEMBLY (See page IP-28)
- 14. INSTALL COWL SIDE TRIM SUB-ASSEMBLY RH
 HINT:

Use the same procedures for the cowl side trim subassembly RH and the cowl side trim sub-assembly LH (See page IP-28).

- 15. INSTALL FRONT DOOR OPENING TRIM RH WEATHERSTRIP
- 16. INSTALL FRONT DOOR SCUFF LH PLATE HINT: (See page IP-29)
- 17. INSTALL INSTRUMENT PANEL FINISH PANEL SUB-ASSEMBLY LOWER (See page IP-29)
- 18. INSTALL FRONT DOOR SCUFF RH PLATE HINT: Use the same procedures for the front door scuff RH plate and the front door scuff LH plate.
- 19. INSTALL INSTRUMENT PANEL FINISH PANEL LOWER (See page IP-30)
- 20. INSTALL CONSOLE PANEL UPPER FRONT (See page IP-30)
- 21. INSTALL FRONT SEAT ASSEMBLY (See page SE-45)
- 22. CONNECT CABLE TO NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL
- 23. PERFORM INITIALIZATION
 - (a) Perform initialization.

HINT:

Some systems need initialization when disconnecting the cable from the negative battery terminal.

- 24. INSPECT CHECK POWER SEAT FUNCTION
- 25. INSPECT SEAT HEATER OPERATION
- 26. INSPECT SRS WARNING LIGHT
 - (a) Inspect the SRS warning light (See page RS-25).
