WARNING REGARDING SERVICING OF SUPPLEMENTAL RESTRAINT SYSTEM (SRS) EQUIPPED VEHICLES

- MITSUBISHI dealer personnel must thoroughly review this manual, and especially its GROUP 52B Supplemental Restraint System (SRS), before beginning any service or maintenance of any component of the SRS or any SRS-related component.

The SRS includes the following components: SRS diagnosis unit, SRS warning lamp, air bag module, clock spring and intercon necting wiring. Other SRS-related components (that may have to be removed/Installed in connection with SRS service or maintenance) are indicated in the table of contents by and asterisk (*).

- 1. REMOVAL OF INSTRUMENT LOWER PANEL AND SUNGLASS POCKET ASSEMBLY
 - (1) Push the upper part of the sunglass pocket (① in the figure) from both sides and remove the stopper ②.
 - (2) Pull the sunglass pocket out towards you with the rotating shaft functioning as a fulcrum.

Caution

Do not remove the sunglass pocket rotating shaft from the instrument lower panel.

- (3) Remove the instrument lower panel mounting screw 3.
- (4) Remove other instrument lower panel mounting screws.

9. REMOVAL OF AIR OUTLET CENTER PANEL ASSEMBLY


- (1) Remove the cool air bypass lever cable of the air outlet center panel assembly at the heater unit side.


