Precautions for Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) "AIR BAG" and "SEAT BELT PRE-TENSIONER"

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The Supplemental Restraint System such as "AIR BAG" and "SEAT BELT PRE-TENSIONER", used along with a front seat belt, helps to reduce the risk or severity of injury to the driver and front passenger for certain types of collision. Information necessary to service the system safely is included in the SRS and SB section of this Service Manual.

WARNING:

- To avoid rendering the SRS inoperative, which could increase the risk of personal injury or death in the event of a collision which would result in air bag inflation, all maintenance must be performed by an authorized NISSAN/INFINITI dealer.
- Improper maintenance, including incorrect removal and installation of the SRS, can lead to personal injury caused by unintentional activation of the system. For removal of Spiral Cable and Air Bag Module, see the SRS section.
- Do not use electrical test equipment on any circuit related to the SRS unless instructed to in this Service Manual. SRS wiring harnesses can be identified by yellow and/or orange harness connectors.

Precautions

- When removing or disassembling any part, be careful not to damage or deform it. Protect parts, which
 may get in the way with cloth.
- When removing parts with a screwdriver or other tool, protect parts by wrapping them with vinyl or tape.
- Keep removed parts protected with cloth.
- If a clip is deformed or damaged, replace it.
- If an unreusable part is removed, replace it with a new one.
- Tighten bolts and nuts firmly to the specified torque.
- After re-assembly has been completed, make sure each part functions correctly.
- Remove stains in the following way.


Water-soluble stains:

Dip a soft cloth in warm water, and then squeeze it tightly. After wiping the stain, wipe with a soft dry cloth. Oil stain:


Dissolve a synthetic detergent in warm water (density of 2 to 3% or less), dip the cloth, then clean off the stain with the cloth. Next, dip the cloth in fresh water and squeeze it tightly. Then clean off the detergent completely. Then wipe the area with a soft dry cloth.

Do not use any organic solvent, such as thinner or benzine.

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

• Do not use any organic solvent, such as thinner, benzene, alcohol, etc. to clean trims.



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
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
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
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
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

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
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Removal and Installation STANDARD SEAT

1. Remove slide cover.



- 2. Remove vehicle mounting bolts.
- 3. Disconnect the connector and remove seat.

NOTE:


When removing and installing, using shop clothes, protect the parts from damage where it may interfere with others.

POWER SEAT

When removing or installing the seat trim, carefully handle it to keep dirt out and avoid damage.

CAUTION:

- Before removing the front seat, turn the ignition switch off, disconnect both battery cables and wait and least 3 minutes.
- When checking the power seat circuit for continuity using a circuit tester, do not confuse its connector with the side air bag module connector. Such an error may cause the air bag to deploy.
- Do not drop, tilt, or bump the side air bag module installing in the seat. Always handle it with care.
- 1. Remove slide cover.



NOTE:

Slide the seat forward, then disengage the tabs on the front RH/LH of slide cover and tabs engaged into the rail. Then pull the cover toward the rear of the vehicle.

2. Slide the seat until the body mounting bolts (4) are visible and a tool can be inserted.

NOTE:

When disassembling the driver seat after removal, set the front/rear cushion lifter to the top position.

- 3. Disconnect the battery negative cable.
- 4. Remove the harness connector for the side air bag module.
- 5. Remove the body mounting bolts.
- 6. Remove the power seat harness connector and vehicle harness fixing clip out of the vehicle.

NOTE

When removing and installing, using shop clothes, protect the parts from damage where it may interfere with others.




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Disassembly and Assembly of Seatback SEATBACK TRIM (WITH SIDE AIR BAG)


- Unfasten fastener on the back of seatback.
- 2. Remove lower retainer.



3. Remove nuts, and remove inner cross-fixed stay.



4. Hang a wire on the snap ring, and pull upward to remove. Remove lumber support lever knob.




5. From the back of the seatback, press the headrest holder tab of the stay pipe hole to disengage. Then pull the headrest holder up to remove.

NOTE:

Before installing the headrest holder, check its orientation (front/rear and right/left).

6. After removing seatback trim & pad, remove hog rings to separate pad and trim.



Removal of Seatback Assembly

To remove seatback assembly, follow steps 1 to 2. After that, remove side air bag connector and bolts (4).
 NOTE:

When assembling the seatback frame, make sure that the reclining device are locked on both sides, and be sure to temporarily tighten the bolts, then tighten them finally.

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
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
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SEATBACK TRIM (WITHOUT SIDE AIR BAG)


1. Disengage retainers in the lower part at the back of seatback.



2. Pull off seatback trim.



3. Hang a wire on the snap ring, and pull upward to remove. Remove lumber support lever knob.




4. Pick up and push up the headrest holder tab to remove.

NOTE:

Before installing the headrest holder, check its front, rear, right and left orientation for correct installation.

5. Remove seatback trim.



Removal of Seatback Assembly

To remove seatback assembly, follow steps 1 to 2. After that, remove bolts.

NOTF:

When assembling the seatback frame, make sure that the reclining device are locked on both sides, and be sure to temporarily tighten the bolts, then tighten them finally.


Be sure to set the front/rear cushion lifter to the top position.

Disassembly and Assembly of Seat Cushion Trim


1. Hang a wire on the snap ring, and pull upward to remove. Remove lifter dial and reclining dial.




2. Remove seat harness and bolts from back of seat cushion.

NOTE:

When installing bolts, make sure both sides of the slide are locked. Be sure to temporarily tighten the bolts before final tightening.



3. Remove retainer from back side of the cushion.



4. Pull off trim and remove hog rings.

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

Removal and Installation

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
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Sedan and wagon models both have similar rear seat removal and installation procedures.

SEAT CUSHION


 Pull the lock at the front bottom of the seat cushion forward (1 for each side), and pull the seat cushion upward to release the wire from the plastic hook, then pull the seat cushion forward to remove.



Remove hinge bolt, and pull out the pin from the hole on the seatback.

IN THE SEATBACK (WAGON MODELS)

- 1. Remove luggage floor center front finisher. Refer to EI-27, "Removal and Installation (Wagon Models)".
- Remove seat cushion.
- 3. Remove bolt and pull the rear seatback trim and pad upward to release the wire from the hook.
- 4. Remove nuts and seatback.




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




REAR CENTER BRACKET


