Towing Subaru Vehicles

The following towing policy applies to all Forester models, 1990 through present model year Legacy (including Outback), 1993 through present model year Impreza (including Outback Sport), and 1992 and later SVX.

Manual transmission all wheel drive (AWD) vehicles can be towed with *all four wheels on the ground* in neutral or with *all four wheels off the ground* on a trailer. Towing must *never* be attempted with only two wheels on the ground or two wheels on a dolly.

Manual transmission front wheel drive (FWD) vehicles can be towed with *all four wheels on the ground in neutral* or with *two front wheels off the ground*. When towing with all four wheels on the ground, the steering wheel must not be locked (move the ignition to the first position away from LOCK) and the parking brake must be released.

Automatic transmission all wheel drive (AWD) vehicles *can not* be towed with *any wheels on the ground*. The vehicle can only be towed on a trailer with *all four wheels off the ground*. Transmission in PARK.

Automatic transmission front wheel drive (FWD) vehicles can be towed with *front wheels off the ground* or *all four wheels off the ground*. Transmission in PARK.
