DOOR FABRIC PERLING OFF

If you receive a customer complaint of the fabric trim peeling away from the door panel, do not replace the door panel. Follow the instructions below to repair the door panel.

NOTE:

DO NOT REMOVE THE DOOR PANEL FROM THE VEHICLE.

MATERIALS NEEDED

Disposable latex gloves or equivalent. Cyanoacrylate glue, examples: 3M Part No. 051135-08155 "Quick Fix Adhesive".

NOTE: THE GLUE MUST BE ABLE TO BOND PLASTIC TO PLASTIC FIBER.

- 1. Carefully pull back the fabric trim only in the area peeling away. not remove the whole trim piece.
- 2. Apply the glue to the back of the fabric trim.
- 3. Apply pressure to hold the fabric trim in place for a minimum of five minutes.

This procedure can be claimed for vehicles within the terms of the Subaru Limited Warranty and using the following:
