
5. Spark Plugs

A: REPLACEMENT

- 1) Disconnect battery ground cable.
- 2) Remove intake duct and intake chamber.
- 3) Remove washer tank and put it aside.
- 4) Disconnect spark plug cord.
- 5) Remove spark plug with a plug-wrench.



6) Set new spark plug.

Recommended spark plug:
Non-TURBO model;
CHAMPION RC10YC4
NGK BKR5E-11
NGK BKR6E-11
TURBO model;
NGK PFR6G
Spark plug gap
0.7 — 0.8 mm (0.028 — 0.031 in)
```

7) Tighten spark plug lightly with hand, and then secure with a plug-wrench to the specified torque.

Tightening torque:

24 N·m (2.4 kgf-m, 18 ft-lb)

NOTE:

- Be sure to place the gasket between the cylinder head and spark plug.
- If torque wrench is not available, tighten spark plug until gasket contacts cylinder head; then tighten further 1/4 to 1/2 turns.
