6. Front Regulator and Motor Assembly

A: REMOVAL

1) Remove the front door trim. <Ref. to EI-59, FRONT DOOR, REMOVAL, Door Trim.>


2) Remove the sealing cover.

CAUTION:

- Carefully remove the butyl tape. Excessive force will easily break the cover.
- If cover gets broken, replace it with a new part.




- 3) Remove the inner pad.
- 4) Attach the battery ground cable and power window switch and turn the ignition to ON.
- 5) Remove the front door glass.
 - (1) Operate the power window switch to move the front door glass to the position where the mounting bolts can be seen.
 - (2) Remove the bolt.



(3) While tilting the glass, remove the windshield glass.


CAUTION:

Avoid impact and damage to the glass.



6) Remove the front regulator and motor assembly.

- (1) Disconnect the connector.
- (2) Remove the bolts, and then remove the front regulator and motor assembly.



B: INSTALLATION

Install each part in the reverse order of removal.


Tightening torque:

C: INSPECTION

1) Disconnect the motor connector.

2) Apply battery voltage between the motor connector terminals and check the motor operation.



Terminal No.	Inspection conditions	Specification
1 (+) - 4 (-)	Apply battery voltage between terminals.	Increase
4 (+) - 1 (-)	Apply battery voltage between terminals.	Decrease

3) If the inspection results in improper operation, replace the front regulator and motor assembly.
