Operation

Panel Switch Operation

- As on the previous model, the display screens of the Multi Display consist of an information mode screen, navigation mode screen, etc. The respective mode screens can be accessed by operating the panel switches that are provided around the multi display.

Touch Switch Operation

- As on the previous model, after the respective mode screen (information, etc.) has been accessed, the user can enter the desired operation by using a finger to directly touch the touch switches in the switch frame that appears in the display screen.

Steering Switch Operation

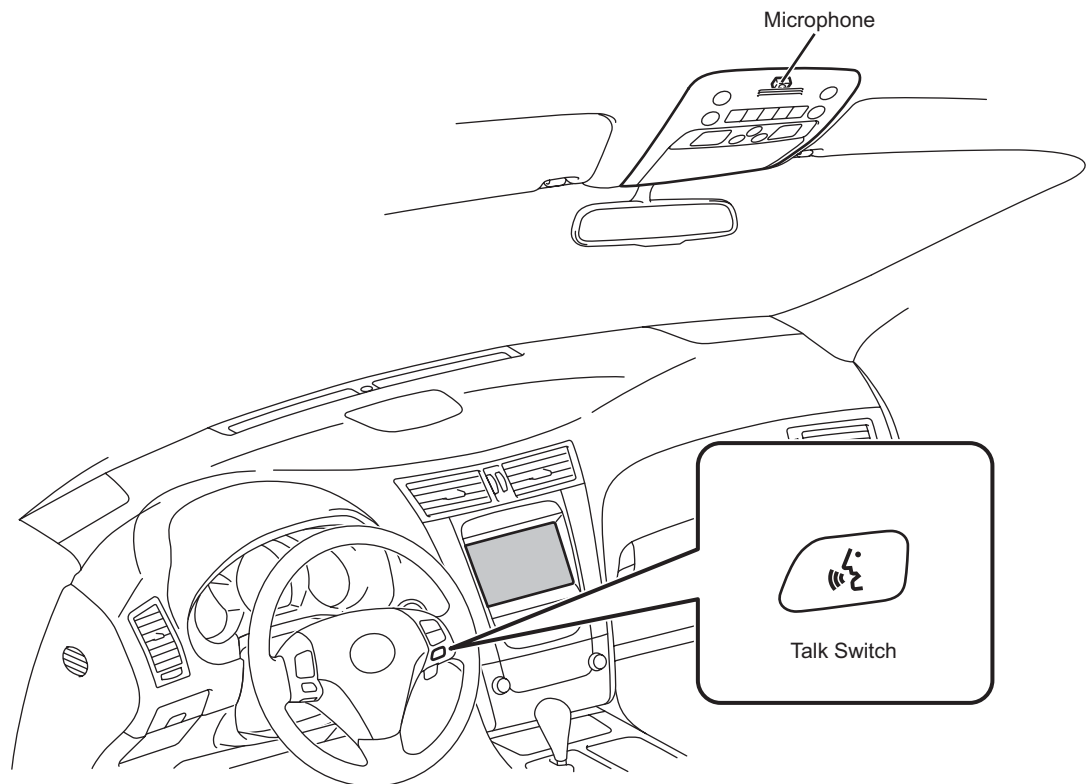
- The steering switches that are provided on the steering wheel enable the driver to adjust the sound volume. For details on the steering switches, refer to the Steering Switches in the Audio System.

Voice Operation*

- By pressing the talk switch, displaying a voice recognition mark on the screen, and speaking into the voice recognition microphone, the driver can issue a voice command to operate the navigation system. Thus, it excels in ease of use.
