General

- The cooling system is a pressurized, forced-circulation type.
- A thermostat, having a bypass valve, is located on the water pump inlet side of the coolant circuit. As the coolant temperature rises, the thermostat opens and the bypass valve closes, so the system maintains suitable temperature distribution in the cylinder head.
- In this system, the cooling fan ECU controls the cooling fan ON and OFF and the fan speed in accordance with the signals from the engine ECU.
