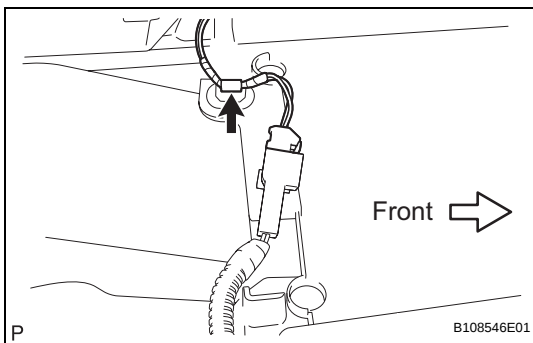


3. REMOVE REAR CONSOLE BOX

- Separate the console box lock control cable assembly from the rear console box.



- Keeping the rear console box pulled in the rear direction of the vehicle, remove the 6 bolts from the left and right sides.

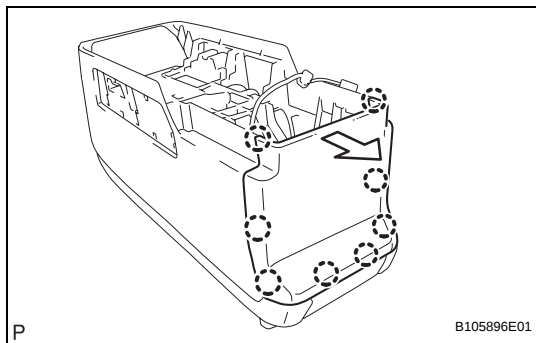


- Disconnect each of the clamp and connector.

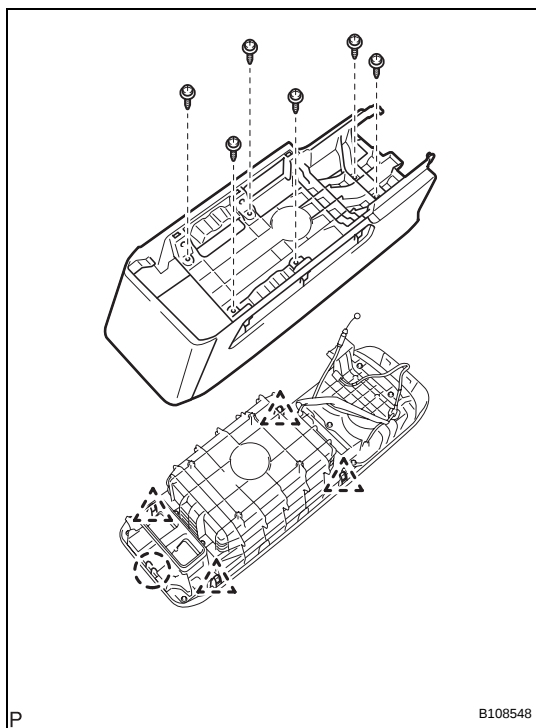

- (a) Disengage the 8 claws and remove the box No.1 side panel.

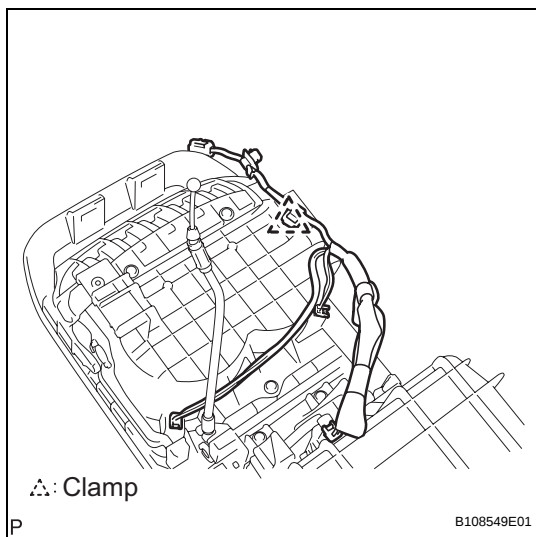


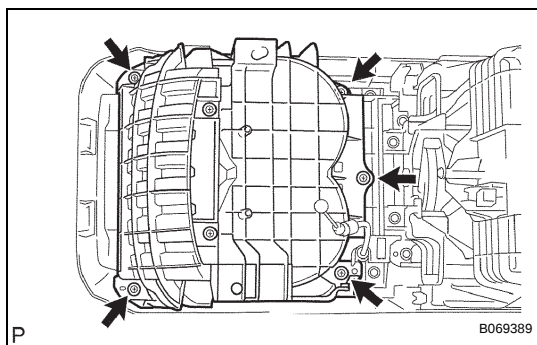

(b) Disengage the 4 clips and the claw, and remove the rear console box lower.

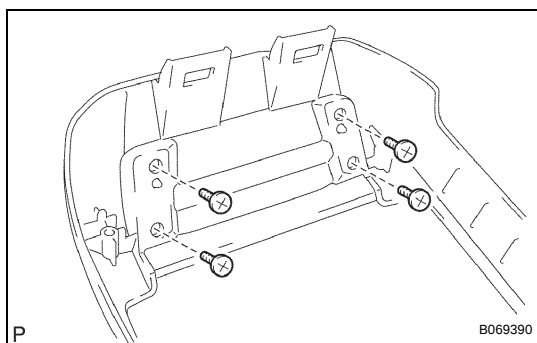

- (a) Disconnect each of the clamp and connectors, and remove the console box light sub-assembly.

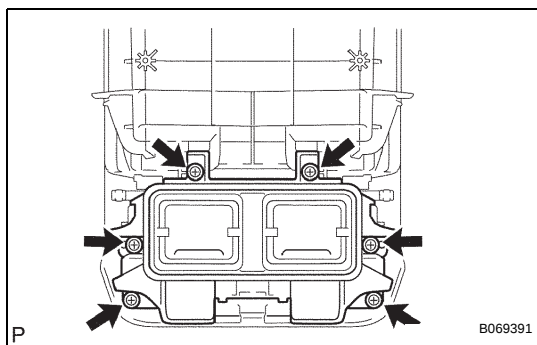
