## 15.PCV Hose

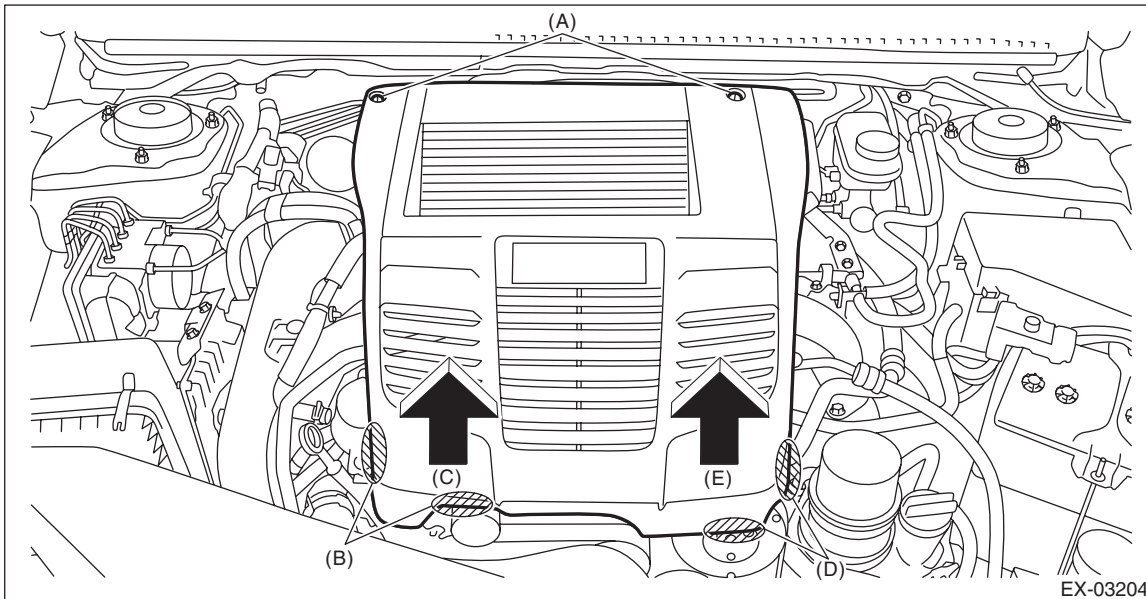
### A: REMOVAL

#### CAUTION:

**Do not remove except when the PCV hose is broken.**

1) Remove the collector cover.

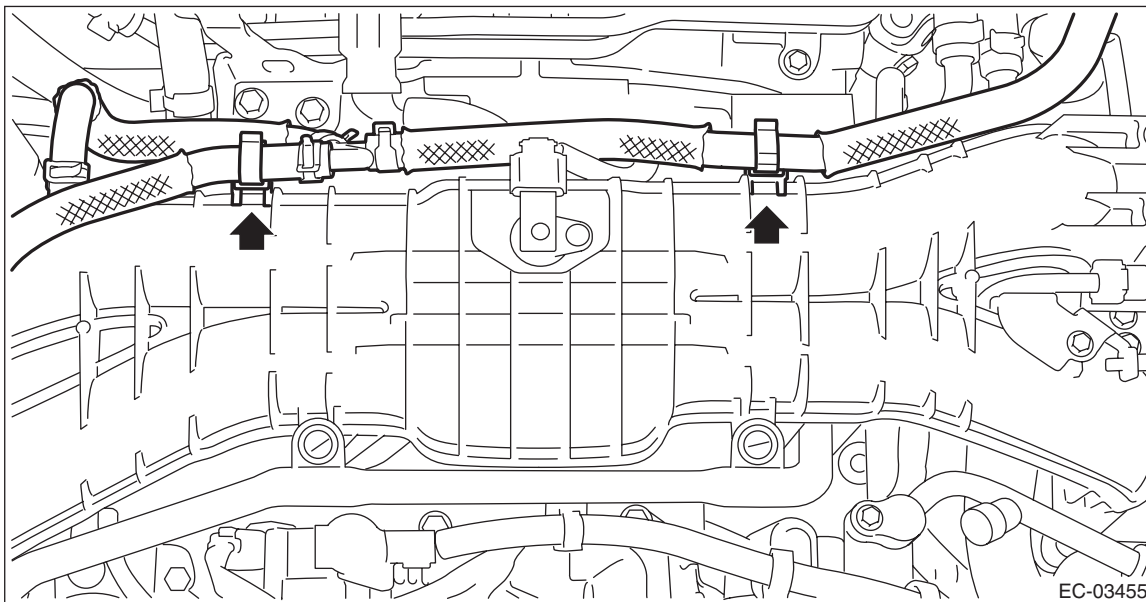
- (1) Remove the clips (A).
- (2) Hold the shaded area (B) by hand and carefully pull the RH side (C) upward.
- (3) Hold the shaded area (D) by hand and carefully pull the LH side (E) upward.



2) Disconnect the ground terminal from battery sensor. <Ref. to NT-5, BATTERY, NOTE, Note.>

3) Remove the intercooler. <Ref. to IN(w/o STI)-38, REMOVAL, Intercooler.>

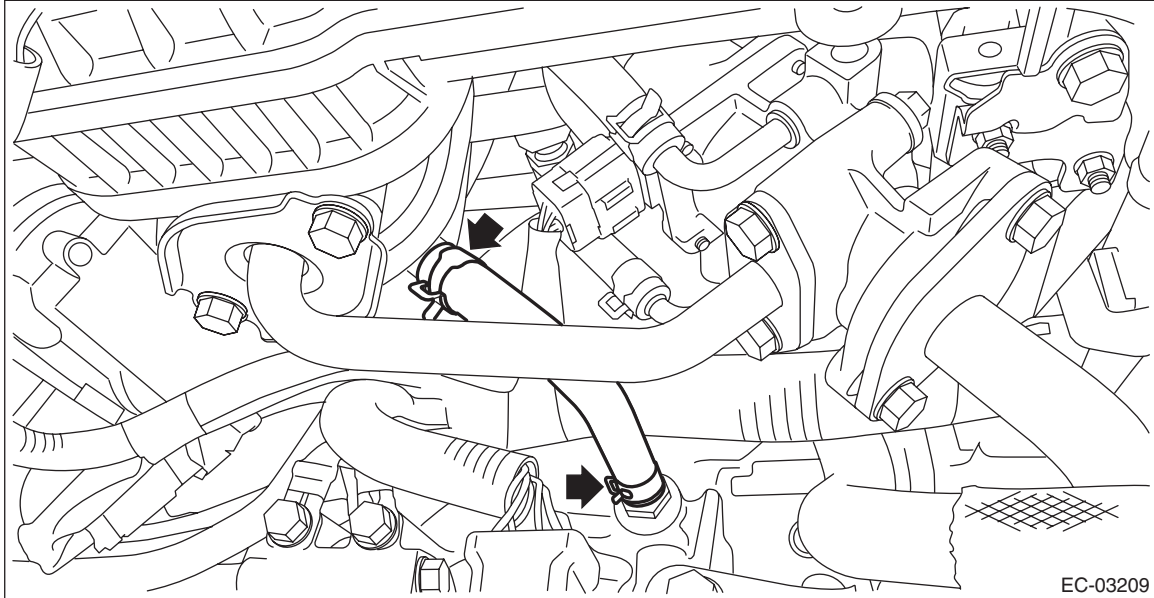
4) Remove the clip securing the brake booster vacuum hose to the intake manifold, and move the brake booster vacuum hose at the locations that do not interfere operation.



## PCV Hose

EMISSION CONTROL (AUX. EMISSION CONTROL DEVICES)

5) Disconnect the PCV hose A from the intake manifold, and remove the PCV hose A from the PCV valve.



### **B: INSTALLATION**

Install in the reverse order of removal.

#### **NOTE:**

When installing the clip which secures the brake booster vacuum hose to the intake manifold, install the clip to the position of alignment mark ▼ of intake manifold.

### **C: INSPECTION**

Check that the PCV hose has no cracks, damage or loose part.
