Wiper de-icer system can be customized on the Subaru Select Monitor.

System name	Initial setting	Customize setting
Wiper de-icer timer	OFF after 15 min.	Continuous operation*

*: When one of the following conditions occurs, continuous operation is suspended and turned off after 15 min.

- Ambient temperature at 5°C (41°F) or more continues for 10 seconds
- Malfunction occurs on ambient sensor.
- Vehicle speed below 15 km/h (9 MPH) continues 15 min.
- Malfunction occurs in CAN communication.

C: REPAIR
