Confirm that the LAN system is working properly before the diagnosis.
Subaru Select Monitor communication line is open or shorted.

DETECTING CONDITION:

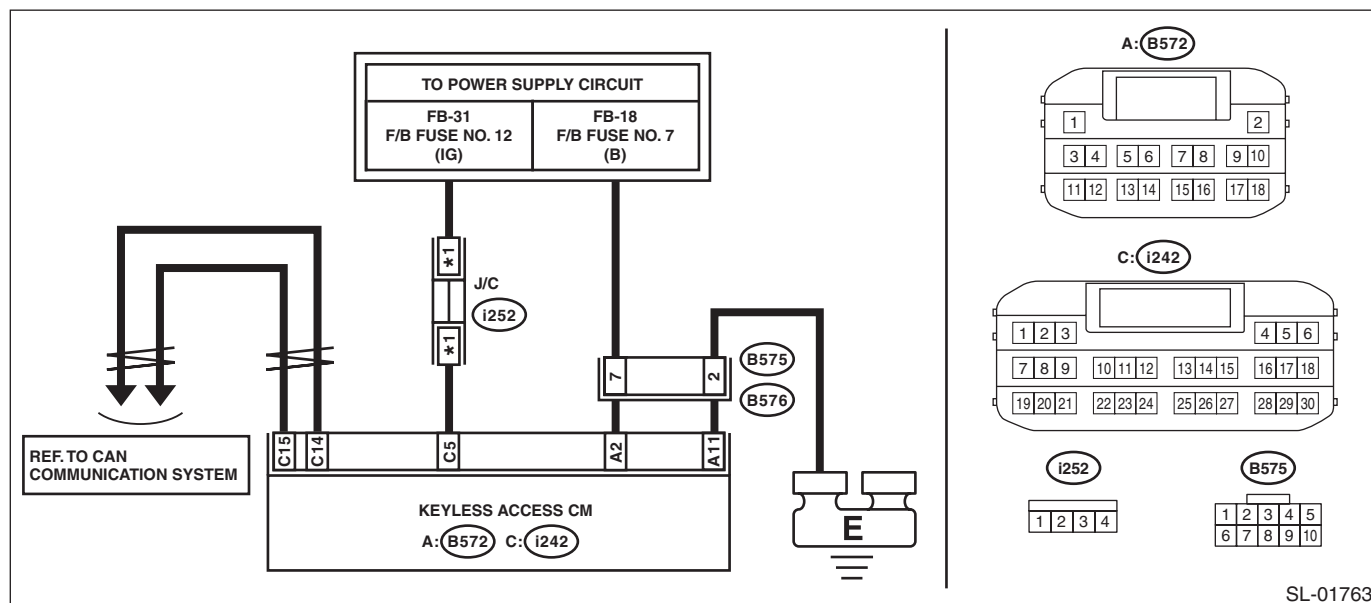
- Defective harness
- Power supply circuit malfunction
- Body integrated unit malfunctioning
- Defective keyless access CM
- Defective Subaru Select Monitor
- Defective CAN communication system

TROUBLE SYMPTOM:

Not communicable with Subaru Select Monitor.

WIRING DIAGRAM:

- CAN communication system <Ref. to WI-83, WIRING DIAGRAM, CAN Communication System.>
- Keyless access system <Ref. to WI-208, WIRING DIAGRAM, Keyless Access System.>

2 CHECK DTC. Read the DTC of the LAN system using the Subaru Select Monitor. <Ref. to LAN(diag)-9, OPERATION, Read Diagnostic Trouble Code (DTC).>	Is DTC detected?	Perform the diagnosis according to DTC.	Go to step 3.
3 CHECK KEYLESS ACCESS CM. 1) Turn the ignition switch to OFF. 2) Disconnect the keyless access CM connector. 3) Connect the disconnected connectors. 4) Perform communication with the keyless access system using the Subaru Select Monitor.	Is communication possible?	It is possible that temporary poor communication occurs.	Replace the keyless access CM. <Ref. to SL-112, REMOVAL, Keyless Access CM.>

For replacement procedure of keyless access CM, refer to the “REGISTRATION MANUAL FOR IMMOBILIZER”.
